face and raised a mound of stone. alongside  
Pits impracticable.

80.82 Intersect the 6th Standard Parallel North at a  
point 4.87 chs. West. of the Standard Cor. to  
Secs. 31 and 32 T. 25 S. R. 58 E.

Set a lime stone 18 x 14 x 6 ins. 13 ins. in  
the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 5 and 6
