North between sections 1 - 6.

Variation 15° East.

Over rolling land.

1300 Foot of Hills, b. E. & W. and ascend.

25.00 Top of Hill bears E. & W. and descend.

40.00 Set a Porphyry stone $15 \times 12 \times 10$ ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, dug pits, $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins., N and S. of stone $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base. alongside.

74.00 Cross Ravine, Course. East and ascend.

80.00 Set a Porphyry stone $12 \times 9 \times 9$ ins. 8 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 22 and 23 S. R's 63 and 64 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. alongside. Pits impracticable.
