North between sections 1-6.

Variation  $15^{\circ}$  East.

Ascend.

17.15 Cross Wash, 20 fks. wide, Course West.

38.00 Top of Ridge, bears E & W. and descend.

40.00 Set a Basalt stone  $10 \times 10 \times 8$  ins.,  $7$  ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, dug pits,  $18 \times 18 \times 12$  ins., Wand S. of stone  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base. alongside.

80.00 Set a Basalt stone  $20 \times 16 \times 12$  ins.  $15$  ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 21 and 22 S., R's 63 and 64 W., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. alongside. Pits impracticable. Land mountainous.
