Ascend.

17.15 Cross Wash, 20 lks. wide, Course West.

.38.00 Top of Ridge, bears S. & W. and descend.

.40.00 Set a Basalt stone 10 x 10 x 8 ins., 7 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and S. of stone $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base. alongside.

.80.00 Set a Basalt stone 20 x 16 x 2 ins. 15 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 21 and 22, R's 63 and 64 N. marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. alongside. Pits impracticable.
Land mountainous.
