

N. B. T 2 S., R 6 E., Mt. D. M.

Chains:

North between sections 1 - 6.

Variation 15° East.

Ascend.

18.00 Top of Ridge, bears S. 4 W. and descend.

32.50 Enter wash, course East.

40.00 Set a Basalt stone $24 \times 12 \times 10$ ins., 18 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

45.50 Leave wash, course East.

78.35 Intersect the 5^{th} Standard Parallel South at a point 15.77 chs. West of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 31 and 36. Tps. 20 S., R. 6 E., which is a stone in stone mark from point I.

Set a Basalt stone $14 \times 12 \times 10$ ins. 9 ins. in the ground, for Closing Cor. to Tps. 21 S., R's 63 and 64 E., marked C. C. with 6 notches on S. E. W. edges, and raised a mound of stone, alongside.
