From the Cor. to Tps. 23 & 24 S., Rs. 62. & 63 E.,

I run West. on a random line on N.B. of Tp.

Va. 15° East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 6 miles &

23-24 S., Rs. 61-62 E.,
which is a Basalt stone in stone
mound.

From which corner I run.

S 89° 54' E, on a true line between sections 6-31.
