2, 3, 34 & 30. ^{Which is a granite stone in stone mound}
from which corner, I runS. $\frac{1}{4}$ W. on a true line, between sections 2 & 3Variation $15^{\circ} 00'$ East.

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone.

12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. onW. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins. E. and W. of
