Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N and S. of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

80.00 Set a post, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 44 and 45 N R's 43 and 44 E, marked T. 45 N S. 31, on N. E. R. 44 E S. 6, on S. E. T. 44 N S. 1 on S. W. and R. 43 E S. 35, on N. W. faces, with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post:
