

North on a true line between sections 1 & 6

Va $18^{\circ}\frac{1}{2}'$ East.

Ascend

8.00 Top of Ridge, bears S. 75° W. and descend along W. W. slope of ridge

40.00 Set a Lime stone $15 \times 10 \times 7$ ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

65.00 Ravine about 100 feet deep, course N. 75° W. and at

70.00 Ascend out of Ravine.

81.20 Set a post $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long 4 ins. square, with marked stone 12 ins in the ground for cor. to Tps. 44 and 45 N. Rs. 38 & 39 E. marked S 1 R 38 E on W. face, S 6. R 39 E on E. face and T. 44 N. on S. face, with 6 notches on E. W. & S. faces, dug pits S. E. & W. of post $24 \times 18 \times 12$ lengthwise on line, and raised a mound of earth $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft high, 5 ft base around post, at a point 14.00 chs E. of established cor to Tps 44 & 45 N. Which is a trap stone $20 \times 16 \times 10$, marked with 6 notches on each edge. Obliterated the notches on the South edge, as the Monument now stands as the cor. to Tps. 45 N. Rs. 38 & 39 E.

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
