Chains.

North between sections 1 and 6.

Variation 15° 00' East.

Ascend.

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone.  
12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on  
W. face, and raised a mound of stone 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  
3  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post. Pits impracticable.

40.64 Top of Spur, bears N. 77° E. and S. 77° W. and descend.

54.90 Cross Gulch, 87 lks. wide, Course W. and ascend.

74.91 Top of Spur, bears E. and W. and descend.

80.00 Set a post, 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked  
stone 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 27  
and 28 S., R's 60. and 61 E., marked T. 27 S.  
S. 31, on N. E. R. 61 E. S. 6, on S. E. T. 28 S. 1  
on S. W. and R. 60 E. S. 36, on N. W. faces, with 6  
notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone 2  $\frac{1}{2}$   
ft. high, 5  $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post. Pits impracticable.
