## Chains.

West. on a true line between sections 6<sup>th</sup> and 31.

To. 1500' East.

- 11.36 Foot of hill, cross  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. S., and ascend.
- 25.00 Top of hill and descend.
- 40.00 Set a granite stone 18 x 12 x 11 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. alongside. Pits impracticable.
- 49.86 Cross Wash, 200 yds. wide, Course S., and ascend.
- 76.30 Top of Spur, bears N. E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. W. and descend. to allow for convergency at
- 79.48 Set a post, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked stone 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 27
- $\frac{1}{4}$  28 S., R's 60. and 59 E., marked T. 27 S. 31, on N. E. R. 60 E. S. 6, on S. E. T. 28 S. 1 on S. W. and R. 59 E. S. 36, on N. W. faces, with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post. Pits impracticable.
