Ascend.

15.34 Top of Hill bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E., and descend.

24.12 Foot of Hill, bears N.E. and S.W.

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone.

12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. onW. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N. and S. of post 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft.60.00 high, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.80.00 Cross Road N.E. & S.W.
Set a broad stone 22 x 10 x 12 ins. 16 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 29 and 30, R's 62 and 63 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

Vegetation, bunchgrass and sagebrush.
