Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone. 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N. and S. of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.

Set a post, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked stone 12 ins. in the ground, for ^{Standard} Cor. to Twp 28 S., R's 64 and 65 E., marked S. C., N. 38 S. 1. on N., R. 65 E. S. 31 on E. and R. 64 E. S. 36 on W. faces with 6 notches on N. E. & W. faces, and raised a mound of stone $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 5 ft. base, around post. Pits impracticable.
