Chains.

South on a true line between sections 31 and 36.

Yds. 1500' East.

Descend.

40.00 Set a granite stone $1\frac{1}{2}$ x 8 ins., 7 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

61.62 Intersect Boundary line between Nevada, and California at a point which bears 20.800 deg. N. 45° W. from the 609th Mile post, which is a post with chain block, marked N. set firmly in the ground, with mound of stone ~~and earth~~. The Post marked 0.609 on N.W.; elev. on N. E.; elev. on S. W. and 1873 on S. E. sides; from which runs: a flag staff at Camp Mojave, N. 86° 45' E. Black Peak, S. 42° 25' W., and

Set a granite stone 23 x 18 x 13 ins. 17 ins. in the ground, for Closing Cor. to Tps. 33 S., R's 65 and 66 E., marked C. O. with 6 notches on N. E. & edges, and raised a mound of stone, alongside.
