- 5.84 Top of Spur, bears E. and descend.
 15.78 Cross Wash, 200 lks. wide, Course S. 72° E. and ascend.
 40.00 Set a granite stone 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 4 x 12 ins., 16
 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W.
 face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits
 impracticable.
 80.00 Set a post, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked
 stone 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 31
 32 S., R's 65. and 66 E., marked T. 31 S.
 S. 31, on N. E. R. 66 E. S. 6, on S. E. T. 32 S. 1
 on S. W. and R. 66 E. S. 36, on N. W. faces, with 6
 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone 2 $\frac{1}{2}$
 ft. high, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post. Pits impracticable.
