Chains.

From the Cor. to Tps. 31 ^{and} 32 S. & Rs. 63 & 64 E.,
I run,

South on a true line between sections 1 ^{and} 6.

Via. 15° 00' East.

Over rolling land.

15.15 — Intersect Boundary line between California and
Nevada. at a point which bears 7.02 des. S. 45° 46' E.,
from the 592nd Mile post, which is a post
with a charred block marked C. N. set
firmly in the ground. The post marked
0.592 miles on N. W.; Nev. on N. E.;
Cal. on S. W. and 1878 on S. E. sides;

From which bears
North Peak, Newberry Mountain N. 57° 15' E.,

and

Set a granite stone 19 x 11 x 7 ins. 14 ins. in
the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 1 and 6
marked C. C. with 1 notch on N. and 5 notches on
S. edges, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. S. E., and, W. of
stone, 5½ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 2 ft.
high, 4½ ft. base. alongside.
Land rolling.

Soil 3rd rate

Vegetation, sagebrush.
