South on a true line between sections 35 and 36.

Over Mesa, sloping S.W.

5.39 Intersect Boundary line between California and Nevada, at a point which bears 9.03 chs. $S. 45^{\circ} \frac{1}{4} E.$,

from the 599th Mile post, which is a post with chain block marked C. N., with pits and earth mound. The post marked C. 599 miles on N. W.; Nev. on N. E.; Cal. on S. W. as 1873 on S. E. sides; from which bears W. Peak of Humboldt mountain, $N. 21^{\circ} E.$, and

Set a granite stone $13 \times 12 \times 6$ ins. 9 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 35 and 36 marked C. C. with / notch on E. and 5 notches on W. edges and raised a mound of stone. alongside.
