South on a true line between sections 26 and 27.

Va. 10° 00' East.

Descend.

4.00 Cross Wash, 150 lks. wide, Course N. 80° W.

5.88 Intersect Boundary line between California and Nevada. at a point which bears 27. 82 deg. N. 45 $\frac{3}{4}$ ° W.

from the 598th Mile post, which is a post with drama break, marked to N, with pits in earth around. The post marked 0.598 miles on N. W.; Nerv. on N.E. Cal. on S. W. and 1873 on S.E. sides, from which bears N. end of Newberry mountain N. 28° 00' E., and Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground, for ^{Closing} Cor. to Secs. 26 and 27 marked T. 32 N R. 64 E., on N. S. 26 on E. and S. 27 on W. faces, with 2 notches on N. and 1 notch on S. faces, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N. E. W. of post, 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.
