33.00 Cross Wash, 225 lks. wide, Course E.

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone.
12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on
W. face, and raised a mound of stone $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high,
 $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post. Pits impracticable.

43.00 Cross Wash, 175 lks. wide, Course E.

62.40 Intersect Boundary line between Nevada. and
California at a point which bears 24.98 Sec. S. $45^{\circ}E$.

from the ⁶⁰⁷~~608~~th Mile post, which is a post with
charred block, marked C. N., with pits and a mound
of stone and earth. This post marked a
