Set a post 3 1/2 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. 12 ins. in the ground, for Standard 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked S. C. 1/4 on N. face, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ⁰ and ^W of post 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base around post.

Set a post 4 1/2 ft. long, 4 ins. square. 12 ins. in the ground for Standard cor. to Pgs. 46⁰ and 47^E marked S. C., T. 46^N on ^W R 47^E. S 31. on East R 46^E S. 36 on ^W faces with 6 notes on ^W E. and ^W faces, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. 76⁰ ^W of post, 6 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, 4 1/2 ft. base around post.
