40.00 Set a basalt stone  $15 \times 10 \times 8$  ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for Standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked S. C.  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. <sup>alongside</sup> Pits impracticable.

45.06 Cross Wash, 10 lks. wide, Course S. and ascend.

75.00 Enter hills, bear  $N. 15^{\circ} W.$  <sup>and</sup>  $S. 15^{\circ} E.$

80.00 Set a basalt stone  $13 \times 11 \times 9$  ins. 9 ins. in the ground for Standard Cor. to Secs. 31 and 32, marked S. C., with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. edges and raised a mound of stone. <sup>alongside</sup> Pits impracticable.
