Chains.

Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Tps. I made a change of 10 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by subtracting same from the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing.

From the Cor. to Tps. 7 & 8, Rs. 40 & 41, I run,

West on a true line between sections 1 and 36.

Va. 15° 55' East.

Ascend.

28.00 Top of Mountain, bears N. 40° E. and descend.

40.00 Set a Basalt stone 14 x 10 x 6 ins., 9 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. alongside Pits impracticable.

45.65 Cross Gulch, 200 lks. wide, Course S. and ascend.

80.00 Set a Basalt stone 14 x 8 x 6 ins. 9 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 1, 2, 35 and 36, marked with 5 notches on W. and, notch on E. edges and raised a mound of stone. alongside Pits impracticable. Land mountainous.
