21.50	<p>Cross Gulch, 100 lks. wide, Course E. and cross Piper's Toll road, bears E. <math>\frac{1}{2}</math> W. <math>\frac{1}{2}</math> ascend.</p>
40.00	<p>Set a granite stone <math>14 \times 9 \times 7</math> ins., 9 ins. in the ground, for <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> Sec. Cor., marked <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> on W. face, and raised a mound of stone. alongside Pits impracticable.</p>
41.00	<p>Top of Ridge, bears E. <math>\frac{1}{2}</math> W. and descend.</p>
68.80	<p>Cross Wash, 90 lks. wide, Course S. E. and ascend.</p>
80.00	<p>Set a basalt stone <math>16 \times 12 \times 4</math> ins., 11 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 31 &amp; 36, marked with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on W. edges and raised a mound of stone. alongside Pits impracticable. from which</p>
