 40.00 Set a Basalt-stone $12 \times 12 \times 5$ ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on *W* face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
57.00 Top of Ridge, bears $N. 50^{\circ} E$ and $50'$ and descend.
 81.87 Intersect the 1st Standard Parallel *cut* at a point 8.77 chs. East, of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 33 and 34 T. 4 S. R. 39 E. at which point I

 Set a Basalt-stone $11 \times 11 \times 5$ ins. 8 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 3 and 4 marked C. C. with 3 notches on E. and 3 notches on *W.* edges and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
