Set a granite stone 20 x 15 x 10 ins. 15 ins. in
 the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 31 & 36, marked
 with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on W edges and
 raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.
