Chains, From the corner to Sections 35, 36, 1 and 2 on the South boundary, I run North, between Sections 35 and 36 on Lat 39° 47' N Variation 17 1/2° East.

40.00 Over rolling mts through Nut Pine and Cedar timber Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 S. on N face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., W and S. of post 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base, around post. Whence bears

1/4 Nut Pine 8 ins. diam., S 15° W 15 lbs. dist. marked 1/4 S. B. T.

1/4 Nut Pine 17 ins. diam., N 18° E 49 lbs. dist. marked 1/4 S. B. T.

53.00 Cross Ravine Course NW. Ravine about 40 feet deep, course NW, and ascend

71.00 30.00 Set a Granite stone 16 x 14 x 12 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25, 26 and 35, 36 marked with 1 notch - on S. and 1 notch - on E. edges and raised a mound of stone alongside. Whence bears

1/4 Nut Pine 18 ins. diam., N 86 1/2° E 41 lbs. dist. marked T. 23 N R. 39 E S. 25 B. T.

1/4 Nut Pine 16 ins. diam., N 43° E 39 lbs. dist. marked T. 23 N R. 39 E S. 36 B. T.

1/4 Nut Pine 11 ins. diam., S 54 1/2° W 20 lbs. dist. marked T. 23 N R. 39 E S. 35 B. T.

1/4 Nut Pine 14 ins. diam., N 16° W 30 lbs. dist. marked T. 23 N R. 39 E S. 26 B. T.

Land mountainous and heavily timbered Nut Pine and Cedar timber Soil rocky and 3rd rate.
