Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. on W face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins. No and 1 of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

Intersect the Fifth Standard Parallel North at a point 39.86 chs. West of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 35 and 36 T. 31 N. R. 66 E

Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set in the ground, marked T. 31 N. R. 66 E. S. Cor N. S. 36 on E and S 35 on W. faces, with 5 notch 4 on W and 1 notch on E edges.

and pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each sec., $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.

At point of intersection I

Set a post $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to secs. 1 and 2 marked

C. C., T. 31 N. R. 66 E on S. S. 1 on E and S. 2 on W faces with 1 notch on E and 5 notch 4 on W faces, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. S. E & W of post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.
