Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam. with marked stone, 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on *N* face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., *N* and *S* of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, around post.

Intersect the *Sixth* Standard Parallel North at a point 39.31 chs. West of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 32 and 33 T. 31 N. R. 66 E

Which is a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, firmly set in the ground, marked D.C. T. 31 N. R. 66 E on N. S 33 on E and S 32 on W. faces, with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W edges.

and pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. N. E & W. $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.

At point of intersection I

Set a post $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to secs. 4 and 5 marked C.C., T. 30 N. R. 66 on S. 4 on E and S. 5 on W faces with 4 notches on E and 2 notches on W faces, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. S. E & W of post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.
