23.00 Cross Gulch, 100 yds. wide, Course $S. 30^{\circ} E$ and ascend.

40.00 Set a basalt stone $17 \times 10 \times 8$ ins., 11
ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N .
face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits
impracticable.

Corner set on
Top of Spur, bears N . and E . and descend.

80.00 Set a basalt stone $18 \times 10 \times 10$ ins. 12 ins. in the
ground, for Cor. to Tps. 1 N ., R's 49 and
50 E., marked with 6 notches on N , E . edges,
and raised a mound of stone, ^{alongside} Pits impracticable.
