Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Tp., I made a change of 5 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by subtracting same from the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing.

From the Cor. to Tps. 1 N. Rs. 48 & 49 E.,

I run,

North on a true line between sections 31 & 36,

Va. 15052' East.

Ascend.

33.65 Cross Wash, 15 lks. wide, Course ϕ . 24° W.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 20 x 15 x 10 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on W. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a basalt stone 17 x 12 x 9 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 31 & 36 marked with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on W. edges and raised a mound of stone alongside, Pits impracticable.
