40.00 Set a granite stone 4 x 10 x 7 ins., 9 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on *N.* face, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins., *N.* and *S.* of stone 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, alongside.

49.86 Cross Wash, 35 lks. wide, Course S. 53° W.

80.00 Set a granite stone N x 12 x 9 ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 1 and 2 S. R's 49 and 50 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, dug pits, 24 x 18 x 12 ins. lengthwise on each line, N. S. E. and W. of stone, 6 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 5 ft. base.
