- 26.00 Top of Spur, bears N. 28° E. & S. 28° W. and descend.
- 37.60 Head of Ravine, Course S. 20° W. and ascend
- 40.00 Set a basalt stone 15 x 11 x 4 ins.,
ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on
face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits
impracticable.

80.37 Intersect Mt. Diablo Base Line,
15.18 chs. W. of cor. to Tps. 1 N., R's.

Set a basalt stone 16 x 10 x 8 ins. 11 ins. in the
