Chains North, on a ^{true} ~~random~~ line between Sections 5 and 6.
Variation N 25° E East.

Descend.

17.50 Cross Gulch, 8 fks. wide, Course S 40° W.

40.00 Set a lava stone 20 x 16 x 14 ins., β ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

84.89 Intersect the North Bdy. of H. at a point 1.68 chs. East of the Closing Cor. to Secs. 31 and 32. Which is a granite stone in stone mound R. 44 at which point I.

Set a granite stone 18 x 10 x 12 ins. 12 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 5 and 6 marked C. C. with J notch on E. and / notch on W. edges and raised a mound of stone ^{alongside.} Pits impracticable.
