Chains.

Before proceeding ~~farther~~ with the exteriors of this Tps. I made a change of 5 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by subtracting same from the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing.

From the ^{Standard} Cor. to Tps. 44, Rs. 44 & 45 E.,

I run,

North on a true line between sections 31 & 36.

Va. 15058' East.

Descend.

28.00 Cross Gulch, 11 lks. wide, Course N. 65° W. and ascend.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 22 x 16 x 9 ins., 16 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raised a mound of stone. alongside Pits impracticable.

65.00 Top of Spur, bears N. W. 50° E. and descend.

80.00 Set a basalt stone 17 x 12 x 12 ins., 11 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 20, 30, 31 & 36, marked with 1 notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edges and raised a mound of stone. alongside Pits impracticable.
