40.00 Set a basalt stone 17 x 12 x 5 ins., 11
ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W.
face, and raised a mound of stone. alongside Pits
impracticable.

66.00 Top of Ridge, bears E and W and descend.

85.50 Intersect S. boundary of T. 2 S., R. 44 E., at a
point 1.15 chs. W. of cor. marked for Tps. 2506,
R. 44th 45 E., which is a sand

Set a basalt stone 15 x 11 x 8 ins. 10 ins. in the
ground, for Closing Cor. to Tps. 2 S., R's 44 and
45 E., marked C. C. with 6 notches on S. E. Wedges,
