Chains,

Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Tp.
I made a change of 6 minutes in the latitude arc
of my solar compass by adding same to
the reading previously given, and at noon verified and
corrected same by observation on the sun. I also fur-
ther tested instrument by reversing.

From the Cor. to Tps. 3 S, & Rs. 44. & 45 E,
I run East on a random line on N. B. of Tp.

Va. 15° 53' East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 5 miles
77.62 chs. I arrive at a point 1.70 chs. West of Cor. to Tps,

2 S, Rs. 45 and 46 E,

Which is a granite stone in stone mound

From which corner I run.

N. 89° 48' W. on a true line on N. B. of Section 1,

Ascend.

Va. 15° 59' East.
