40.00 Set a granite stone 17 x 14 x 12 ins., 12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

85.70 Intersect the North Boundary of T<sub>1</sub> at a point 1.70 chs. West of the " Cor. to Secs. 24 and 25. T. 2 S. R. 45 E. at which point I.

Set a basaltic stone 16 x 14 x 7 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 2 and 3 marked C. C. with 2 notches on E. and 4 notches on W. edges and raised a mound of stone <sup>alongside</sup>. Pits impracticable.
