40.00 Set a *basaltic* stone 12 x 10 x 10 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

85.68 Intersect the North Boundary of T₃ at a point 1.32 chs. West of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 32 and 33. T. 2 S. R. 45 E. at which point I.

Set a *basaltic* stone 16 x 12 x 12 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 4 and 5 marked C. C. with 4 notches on E. and 2 notches on W. edges and raised a mound of stone ^{alongside.} Pits impracticable.
