38.78 Cross Gulch, 10 lks. wide, Course S. E. and ascend.

40.00 Set a basaltic stone 12 x 10 x 7 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

57.00 Top of Ridge, bears N. W. & S. E., and descend.

85.80 Intersect the North Boundary of T₁ at a point 1/4 chs. West of the Cor. to Secs. 31 and 32. T. 2 S. R. 45 E. at which point I.

Set a basaltic stone 20 x 12 x 12 ins. / 18 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. 5 and 6 marked C. C. with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. edges and raised a mound of stone ^{alongside}. Pits impracticable.
