I took the latitude and found it to be $38^{\circ} 04' N.$
From the Cor. to Tps. 2 & 3 N., Rs. 46 & 47 E.,
I run West. on a random line on N.B. of Tp.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 5 miles
79.11 chs. I arrive at a point 95 lks. North of Cor. to Tps.

2 & 3 N. Rd. 45-46 E.,
Which is a Ballstone in stone mound

From which corner I run.

$N. 89^{\circ} 54' E.$, on a true line between sections 6-31.

Va. $15^{\circ} 03'$ East.

Descend. Over rolling land.
