Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Twp., I made a change of 16 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by subtracting same from the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing.

From the Cor. to Tps. 1 & 2 N. Rs. 47 & 48 E.,

Which is a Granite Stone 16 x 12 x 9 ins. 11 ins. in ground, with pits & mound of earth.

North on a true line between sections 31-36.

Va. 15° 53' East.

40.00 Set a Porphury stone 14 x 10 x 10 ins., 9 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 on W. face, and raised a mound of stone. alongside Pits impracticable.

63.70 Cross Wash, 16 lks. wide, Course S. 75° W.

80.00 Set a Sand stone 12 x 12 x 0 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25-30-31-36 marked with 1 notch on S. and 3 notches on E edges and raised a mound of stone. alongside Pits impracticable.
