 44.00 Set a basalt stone 16 x 12 x 10 ins., 10
 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W.
 face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits
 impracticable.
 47.00 Enter Timber, bears E. & W.
 69.00 Top of Spur, bears E. & W. and descend.
