40.00 Set a Granite stone 12 x 12 x 10 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

43.00 Top of Ridge, bears N. W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  S. 60° E. and descend.

79.71 Intersect N. B. of Tp. 88  $\frac{1}{2}$  m. West of cor. to secs. 5-6-31-32 which is a Lava stone 13 x 9 x 8 ins. in stone mound

Set a post, 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground, for

A Cedar 16 ins, diam, bears N. 4° W. 216 lks, dist, marked T. 5 N. R. 45 E. S. 31 B. T.
