Chains.

North, on a *true* line between Sections 4 and 5.
Variation *16 3/4* East.

- Ascend*
- 10.00 Top of *Ascend* and descend along *N* slope of *Mountains into deep Cañon*
- 36.00 Enter Cañon about 600 feet deep bears *SW*
- 40.00 Set a *LimE* stone *2 1/2 x 14 x 10 ins.* 18 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on *N* face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable
- 41.00 Dry Channel *14* fts. wide, course *SW and*
Ascend out of Cañon
- 58.00 High rocky *Ridge*, bears *E 1/4 N*, and descend
- 80.04 Enter the *South* Standard Parallel North at a point *45 1/2* chs. *West* of the Standard Cor. to Secs. *32* and *33* T. *31 N* R. *68 E* at which point I set a *LimE* stone *14 x 9 x 7 ins.* 9 ins. in the ground for Closing Cor. to Secs. *4* and *5* marked *C* with *4* notch *W* on *E*. and *2* notch *W* on *W*. edges, and raised a mound of stone alongside.
