40.00 Set a Sand stone 15 x 9 x 7 ins. 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

56.40 Cross Wash, 20 lks. wide, Course E.

64.70 Cross Road, bears, N. W. ^{and} S. E.

80.00 Set a basalt stone 16 x 10 x 5 ins. 11 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25, 30, 31 & 36, marked with / notch on S. and 5 notches on W. edges and raised a mound of stone. alongside, Pits impracticable.
A Spring, bears ~~N. 66° 40' W.~~ N 45° W.
