3.80 Enter Timber, Bears. N. 60° W.

38.60 Cross Wash, 18 lks. wide, Course W and ascend.

40.00 Set a lime stone 12 x 10 x 9 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on W.

80.00 Set a granite stone 18 x 17 x 6 ins. 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 2 and 3 N. R's 51 and 52 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a

mound of stone. alongside. Pits impracticable.
