

General Description

This line runs over nearly level and slightly rolling ground, part of the first mile in Range 4th being mountainous.

The country to the North and South of the line is of the same general character. The grass is rich and abundant.

From the cor. To Tp. 46 N. R. 9 W. 44 & 45 E which is a stone 12x10x9, marked with 6 notches on N. E. & W. sides, and pits N. E. & W. of stone & mound of earth alongside,
I run
