From the corner to Sections 35, 36, 1 and 2 on the South boundary, I run,
North, between Sections 35 and 36.Latitude $38^{\circ}50'N$ Variation. $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ East.

- 13.50 Dry Channel 16 lks. wide, course E
- 26.00 Ascend Mountain
- 37.00 Enter timber $brs E \& W$
- 40.00 Δ Nut Pine 16 ins. diam. which I marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S.
on W face for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins.
W and S of tree $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of
earth around tree.
- 41.00 Top of Wooded peak and descend
- 68.00 Leave timber $brs N E \& W$ enter level land
- 78.00 Cross Dry Channel in ravine 20 lks. wide, bears E
- 80.00 Set a post 4 ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked stone.
12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Secs. 25, 26, 35 & 36
marked T. 12 N.S. 25 on N. E., - R $\frac{3}{4}$ E, S. 36
on S. E., - S. 35 on S. W. and S. 36 on N. W. face
with / notch on S. and / notch on E. edges
dug pits. $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. in each Sec., $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist.,
and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base
around post.

- 42.00 ch. Over mountain
sage and grass
- 31.00 ch. Nut Pine and Cedar timber
soil $2\frac{1}{2}$ rate
