15.40 Creek 10 lks. wide, runs  $N 59^{\circ}W$  and ascend  
40.00 Set a Granite stone  $14 \times 10 \times 8$  ins.  $10$   
ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on  $N$   
face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.

40.50 Top of Ridge, bears  $E \times W$  and descend
