Chains From the corner to Sections 35, 36, 1 and 2 on the South boundary, I run North, between Sections 35 and 36.

Latitude $38^{\circ}46'N$ Variation. 17° East.

Descend along W slope of ridge

40.00 Set a granite stone $17 \times 13 \times 12$ ins. 11 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on face, and raised a mound of stone alongside. Whence bears a Nut Pine 9 ins. diam., $S27^{\circ}W$ 76 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. B. T.

a Nut Pine 11 ins. diam., $N46^{\circ}W$ 85 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{2}$ S. B. T.

57.00 Ravine about 100 feet deep, course $N64^{\circ}W$ and ascend

80.00 Set a granite stone $14 \times 10 \times 8$ ins. 9 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 25, 26, 35 & 36 marked with 1 notch on S. and 1 notch on E. edges and raised a mound of stone alongside. Whence bears

a Nut Pine 10 ins. diam., $N29^{\circ}E$ 57 lks. dist. marked T. 10 W R. 33 E S., 25 B. T.

a Nut Pine 12 ins. diam., $S48^{\circ}E$ 96 lks. dist. marked T. 10 W R. 33 E S., 36 B. T.

a Nut Pine 13 ins. diam., $S63^{\circ}W$ 84 lks. dist. marked T. 10 W R. 33 E S., 35 B. T.

a Nut Pine 12 ins. diam., $N29^{\circ}W$ 45 lks. dist. marked T. 10 W R. 33 E S., 26 B. T.

Land mountainous and heavily timbered

 Soil rocky and $\frac{3}{4}$ rate.
